

Rugoshath Traffic Bot (Free Edition)

User Manual

Thanks for downloading the Rugoshath Traffic Bot. There will be many updates to come, so make sure to keep an eye on your emails to make sure you don't miss any updates and improvements.

RIGHT! LET'S TALK ABOUT MAKING MONEY WITH THIS THING!

We'll get to the "how the software works" part in a second, that's easy and won't take you a minute to figure out, so let's move on for now.

First thing you should do is **head to [Fiverr.com](https://www.fiverr.com) and create an account** if you don't already have one. **It's easy, free, and there's a TON of cash to be made!**

After you've done that, or if you have an account already, set up a new service, ***SELLING WEBSITE TRAFFIC!***

If you're not sure what to put in your title, descriptions or whatever, simply do a search on Fiverr itself for "website traffic", see how others are doing it, how they charge, etc. It doesn't have to be complicated, but **take some time to make it look professional.** This is very important!

Take note of the **number of sales** these people have made already, as well as the number of **orders in queue**. This will give you a general idea of how much you can make using this software. Insane, right?!

Let me show you an example to get you pumped up:

This was the first result I found just now when searching for “*website traffic*” on Fiverr. This is a relatively **new Fiverr user** that’s been **created about a month ago (3 weeks, to be exact)**.

Let’s look at his stats, shall we?

He’s made more than 77 sales already, note that 77 people have left reviews, so how many others **didn’t** leave a review? 100? For now, let’s ignore those who didn’t.

77 sales @ \$5 = **\$385**


He’s also got 14 orders in his queue, meaning that’s another (14 x \$5) \$70, bring his total to... wait for it...

\$455 in his first month! You can do that too, while playing games, watching TV or reading a book, **EASILY!**

Now, let me show you how the software works:

It's so easy, a 2-year-old can do it, let's get started!

You've got 2 screens, one for your project and one for your proxies. And yes, this is an **extremely powerful piece of software** so **proxies are required.**



On the main screen, you simply **enter the URL you want to send traffic to. Remember to include “http://”** in front, like `http://www.google.com/`.

In the “*User Count*” section, you enter the amount of visits you want to send to your site. Okay, before you continue, **let me explain how the software works.**

There are servers where **people get an incentive to visit a site**, this software will **collect those users** and display them next to the **“New Users Found”** text. It will then check which of those users are **currently online** and display it next to **“Active Users”**.

This is where your traffic will come from – **Direct Traffic!**

For example: If a customer buys 1000 visits from you, enter 1500 here, just to be safe. *Rather OVER deliver*, than under deliver. If you enter 1000, it's **not guaranteed** that the “Active Users” will visit the site. **Most will**, but **some won't**, so rather be safe than sorry.

The “Active Users” have a **dashboard** where they have a bunch of URLs, they then click on each one (to visit the target URL) and get paid. Should they miss your URL, or there's an error loading the target page, it **might not pick up** on a tracking system like Google Analytics.

Each time your entered URL gets **displayed** to an “Active User”, it will count as an **“Impression”**, which is displayed next to... you've guessed it: “Impressions”. This is a **general idea of how many visitors you've received** as the software runs. It will always be *slightly lower* than the amount you've entered into the “User Count” box, so **ALWAYS** add a bit more just to be safe.

Threads

Here you simply select the number of threads you want to run, the default is 5. Remember, more threads = more CPU usage. If you're running on an older system, or experience any issues like the bot crashing, the first thing you should try is to lower the threads.

Activity Log

This shows you **exactly** what the software is doing. It will start by **rotating your [proxies](#)**, visit the sources of the traffic, then **checking** the "Active Users". Once it has found enough, it will start sending traffic to your site, otherwise it will loop the first part until there are enough users available.

The message will say ***"Started Sending Visits"***, and as you see the impressions go up, the amount you've entered in the "User Count" box **go down**. Once that number reaches **-20**, the **software will stop**.

If it appears that the software froze, **it didn't**, it's simply busy **collecting data** or running into a problem that it will attempt to **fix itself**. Just leave it to run, **it will do the job** eventually.

Sending 5000 visits generally takes around 30 minutes, just to give you an estimate of what you could expect. **If you run large projects** with a high amount of visits, it's **recommended** you run it on a **[strong VPS](#)** (virtual desktop private server) with **sufficient CPU** as it will make your system run very slow.

Now onto the next tab, the **“Proxies”**. Always **remember to enter your proxies** first **BEFORE** running your project, **private proxies are required** and the **software won’t run without** adding your info here.

First, **copy all your proxies into a text file** (proxies.txt for example), **one per line** in **this format**:

Proxy:Port:Username:Password

Next, enter your *“Username”* into the **“Proxy Username”** box, **do the same with your password**. Now just click the icon next to **“Load Proxies”** and select your **.txt** file where you saved your proxies.

BOOM! You’re good to go!

Switch back to the **main tab** and click the **“Play”** button once you’ve entered all your info. **Your visits are on their way!**
